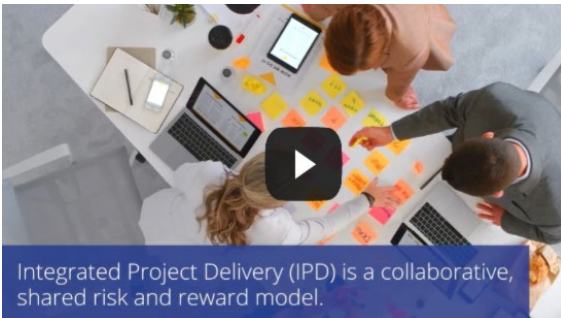

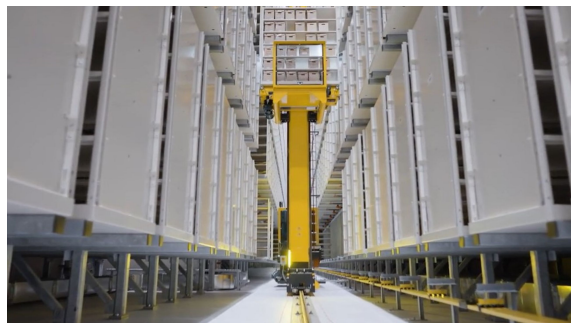
### **City of Merritt Unveils First Batch of Transitional Homes**

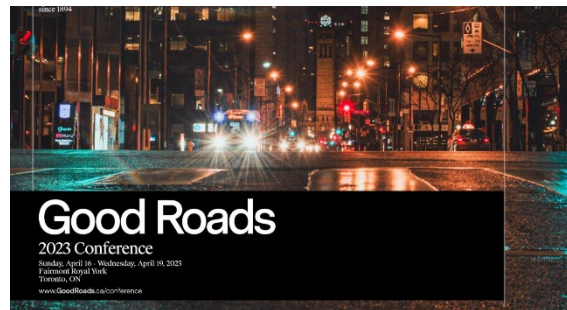
