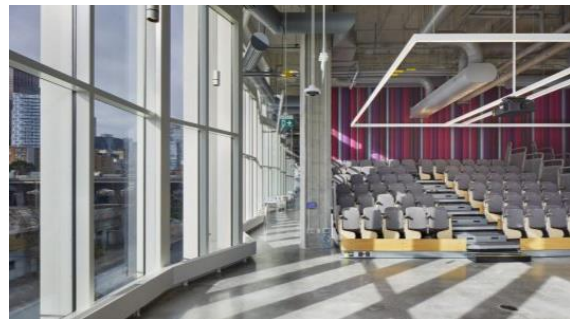

## Leader Profile: Agustin Paz y Mino

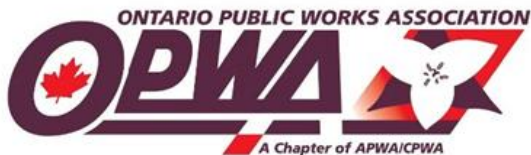


One of our company's [core values](#) is to help build stronger future communities. As project leaders, we build that value into our daily project management approach.
